# **SURF (Survivors Fund)**

### Cyangugu Wellness Centre

- funds were provided by INSPIRE!africa for the reconstruction and creation of the Wellness
  Centre. This building will be a community centre to generate income for AVEGA and
  employment opportunities for genocide survivors as well as for general meetings of AVEGA
  members.
- the building was operational by the end of 2011, with the focus of work being on education, counseling and training.
- INSPIRE!africa also donated monies for two community development workers (one is specialized in health; one is specialized in livelihoods) to provide the training to the widows.
- INSPIRE!africa supporters also provided funds for 100 hygiene kits for the local community

### **Solace Ministries**

#### **Livestock for Widows**

• 2 cows, 80 goats, and 50 bees & beehives purchased by INSPIRE!africa

## **Rwanda Multi Learning Centre (RMLC)**

- 5 full time teachers, INSPIRE!africa subsidizes teachers' salaries
- 150+ students in 2011, enrolled in courses offered in English, computers, business, and music. Over 70 students successfully completed all of their courses in 2011.
- in 2011, the RMLC helped 22% of current students find jobs, and 15% went on to university thanks to the sponsorship program

 INSPIRE!africa provided money for 20 more desks and chairs, as well as office furnishings for the new building

# **Student Sponsorships**

- All 10 students successfully completed their studies and their sponsorship will continue
- Rwanda's school year shifted to be similar to the Canada, UK and US with a September start. Some sponsored students have entered their final year of university; some have completed their high school and are successfully moving onto university.
